Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time secondary student in the 2025-2026 academic year, and a registered member of a Participating First Nation of the Anishinabek Education System (see list below).

- a letter outlining academic achievements, future aspirations, and community involvement; and
- two (2) written academic references.
